

## IQ TESTING VIA TELEHEALTH

To prepare for IQ testing via telehealth, you will need:

- A reliable internet connection
- Several blue or black pens
- A pen that is a color *other than* blue or black (e.g. red, green)

Some of the paper and pencil/pen tests I will administer to you will require me to watch your hands while you execute them. You will need.

- A webcam that can be adjusted during the meeting or
- A computer whose angle be adjusted so I am able to see you work

The environment will need to be quiet and free of distractions.

- Once the child is set up on the call, others must exit the room during testing and need to remain outside of the room until the meeting's conclusion.
- You will need:
  - A clear surface on your desk on which you can write
  - To turn off your cellphone during the session (really off, not on "silent" with vibration), and to turn off the ringers on landlines
  - To disable alerts that come across your computer screen (e.g., those that tell you that you've received a text message or new email, reminders for upcoming appointments or events, news alerts, and the like)
  - To insure that you do not schedule the session at a time that your gardener ordinarily comes and uses a leafblower, you will not have a vacuum cleaner running in the background, and the like
